Augustana 39, St. Norbert 32



St. Norbert falls to Augustana, 39-32, in final 52 seconds

NCAA playoff game tied, 25-25, at the end of the third quarter

Midwest Conference Champion **St. Norbert** led twice but ended up 25 yards shy of defeating CCIW Champion **Augustana** in the 1999 NCAA Division III Championship Football Playoffs.

The Vikings prevailed, 39-32, on a five-yard run by Corey Ungaro and extra point by John Phillips with 52 seconds left. The two teams entered the fourth quarter tied, 25-25.

The Green Knights drove to the Augustana 25-yard-line with 17 seconds left but were unable to score.

St. Norbert won the 1999 MWC Championship with a 9-0 record.
