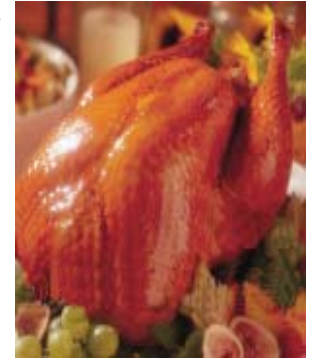


Thanksgiving History

In that year the present governor, William Bradford decided to ask the Wampanoag Indians to join them in a big harvest feast. The Indians were invited because Squanto, an English-speaking Indian, helped the pilgrims grow crops and survive in the new land.



After food was harvested, Thanksgiving was rejoiced to honor gathering so many crops. Although the thirteen colonies didn't celebrate it on the same Thursday till October 1777.

Later in October 1789 our first president George Washington was the first to declare the holiday, but there was no exact day to honor it.

During the Civil War in 1863, Abraham Lincoln made his Thanksgiving Proclamation, in which he announced the last Thursday of November to be the day to celebrate Thanksgiving.

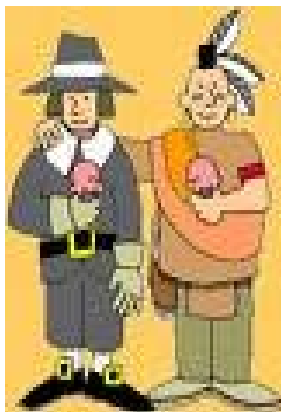

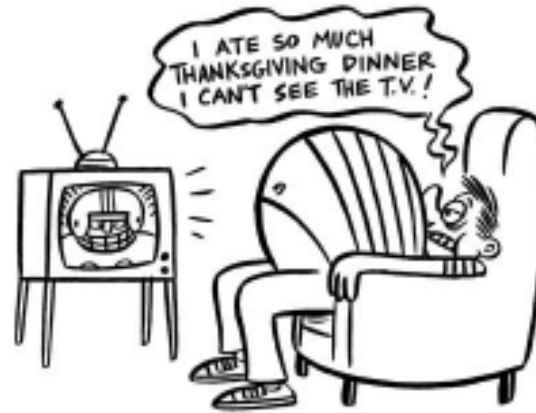
